Coordination

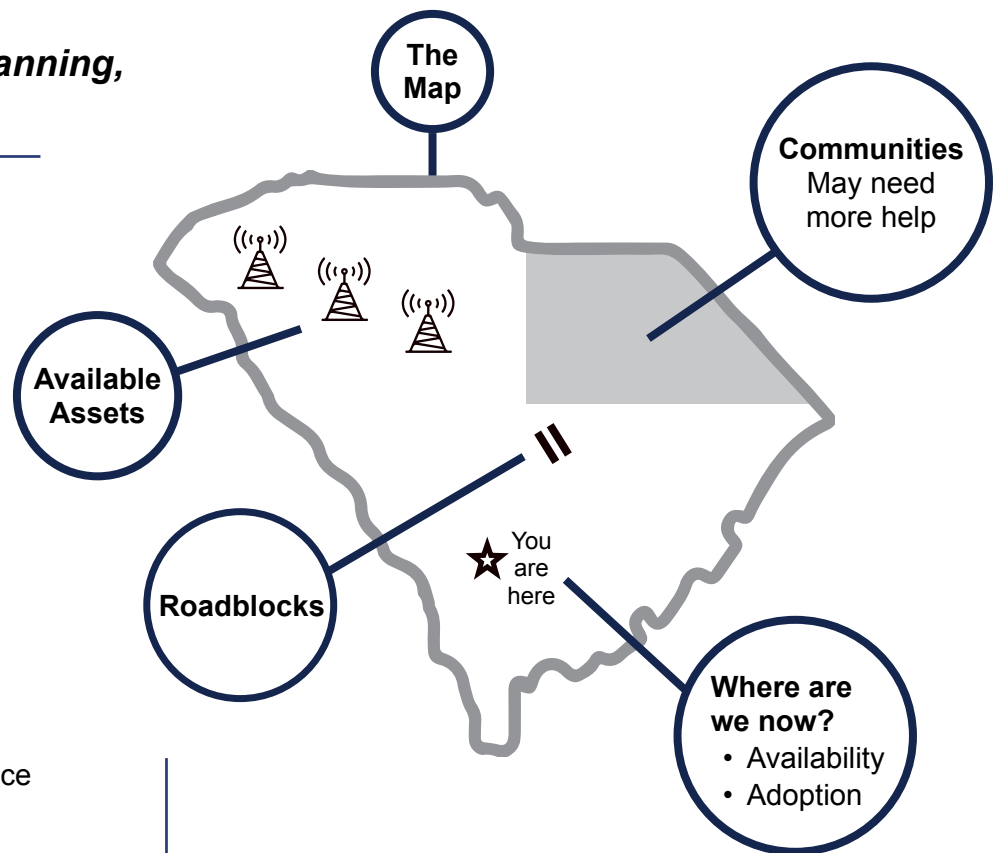
Establishing the Broadband Infrastructure Coordinator (BIC) ensures that broadband develops quickly and efficiently.
